Ride through rolling pastures, along sweeping ridgelines, and across wide-open landscapes where the views of Mauna Kea and the Kohala Coast are nothing short of epic. Expect a mix of scenic cruising, gentle climbs, and flowy descents that make this tour both fun and rewarding.

With premium electric mountain bikes available, you'll enjoy the distance and views with ease, while our expert guides keep the pace comfortable for every rider. A perfect blend of adventure, history, and Hawaii's natural beauty.



DESCRIPTION:

Ride from paniolo (cowboy) country down to Waipi'o Valley Lookout, where sweeping vistas of the Valley of the Kings await. Pedal downhill along quiet back roads until you arrive at old Honoka'a town, a charming community that feels frozen in time.

From Honoka'a, continue another 12 miles to reach the breathtaking Waipi'o Lookout, completing what many call the best bike ride on the Big Island. For those seeking even more adventure, descend into the legendary Waipi'o Valley itself, where hidden backroads once supported the island's thriving sugarcane industry.

This guided experience blends outdoor adventure with Hawaiian history and natural beauty, offering a rare glimpse into one of the most storied landscapes on the Hāmākua Coast. Moderate fitness and confident bike handling are required for this ride.



The Kohala UTV Adventure offers a rare journey into Kohala Iloko — "Inner Kohala" — a land once defined by isolation, rich soils, and abundant waters that sustained a proud and determined people destined to rule. Led by guides rooted in this community, explore private lands, murmuring streams, cascading waterfalls, and lush uplands that remain kapu (forbidden) to all but invited guests.

Your off-road ride begins in historic Hawi and travels from sea to mountain, where the rugged trails open to breathtaking views of Pololū Valley, the Valley of the Long Spear. Along the way, stories of chiefs, warriors, and rebels bring the land to life, blending culture with scenery.

Helmets, goggles, and rain gear are provided for comfort and safety. This 2½-hour experience is both an adventure through wild terrain and a deeper encounter with the living history of Kohala.

DESCRIPTION:

Kohala is a land rich in history and natural beauty, where dramatic landscapes meet timeless Hawaiian culture.

Your journey begins with a scenic drive across vast lava fields created by the island's volcanoes, before giving way to the lush green countryside of North Kohala. Along the way, pass through the charming sugarcane plantation towns of Hawi and Kapa'au, birthplace of Hawaii's first king, King Kamehameha.

From there, venture beyond locked gates onto private land for an experience few visitors ever see. Follow your guide on a 1.25 mile hike along a tranquil stream, encountering a series of waterfalls with the opportunity to swim beneath a refreshing cascade if you wish.

The day concludes with a picnic lunch at a breathtaking private overlook, where you'll take in sweeping views of dramatic sea cliffs, remote valleys, and the striking black sand beach of Pololu Valley.



Journey to the cool, misty slopes of Hualālai Volcano for an adventure that blends geology, nature, and culture. Passing through locked gates for exclusive access, travel off-road up the mountain before beginning a guided hike with an Interpretive Naturalist. The trail reveals a surreal landscape of black lava flows, native forest alive with birdsong, and the dramatic Kaupulehu Crater — the heart of the 1801 eruption. Travel to magnificent coastal viewpoints and stunning lava formations, walk amidst a forest of native birdsong and even scramble through a hidden lava tube.

This tour includes 3–4 miles of moderate to strenuous hiking with up to 1,000 feet of elevation gain and loss on uneven, unpaved trails. Afterward, enjoy a picnic lunch and visit a working Kona coffee farm for a guided tour with tastings of world-famous Kona coffee.

This national historic park was once the home of royal grounds and a place of refuge for ancient Hawaiian lawbreakers. Rich in history and culture, the Place of Refuge takes you back in time of a sacred site.

The St. Benedict's Painted Church overlooks the beautiful and historic Kealakekua Bay. The church, while still an important historical site, is still a vibrant parish today. You will also have an opportunity to taste some of the best coffee on the island during our brief stop. Get more information on their coffee while tasting some of their delicious flavors...



Journey from sea level to the 14,000-foot summit of Maunakea, where world-class clarity meets dramatic beauty. After a picnic-style dinner, ascend to Hawaii's most sacred peak for a sensational sunset above the clouds, surrounded by the world's largest collection of observatories.

This tour involves less than 1,000 feet of walking at extreme elevation, making the experience accessible while still extraordinary.

As darkness falls, descend to a more comfortable elevation to enjoy a private star show. Sip hot cocoa as your guide reveals the night sky through an 11-inch Celestron telescope.

New – Digital Astrophotography! Experience deep space like never before with technology inspired by the Hubble Telescope. View live HD images of galaxies, nebulae, and star clusters on a tablet, and take home digital copies of the evening's celestial highlights.


